Interacting With Employers

Look up the list of employers that will be attending. Pick out a few that interest you and research them. Go to their website, check out their mission statement, and review their current job postings.

During the Regional Career Networking Days, your goal is to connect your goals, values, and company. Before signing off, get the recruiter's contact information and follow up with a thank-you email, including your resume and perhaps a request for an informational interview or ask a few questions. Even if you are exploring, it is important to keep the connection. We suggest following up with contacts quarterly – bi-annually to keep the relationship current.

Email

Online networking is critical in today's career exploration. You will likely interact with an employer via email; remember to be professional, friendly, and enthusiastic. Here is a sample email:
